Last week the City Council for the City of San Antonio again rezoned (i.e., upzoned) Edwards Aquifer recharge zone. This time a highly sensitive section of the Edwards Aquifer recharge zone was rezoned to allow for significantly higher impervious cover. Only Mayor Hardberger dissented from this ill-advised decision. We need more elected officials to demonstrate the leadership and vision shown by Mayor Hardberger.

Carlos Guerra (Express News) has written extensively about the threats posed by this unbridled expansion.

A Press Conference has been scheduled to raise awareness on the threats posed by the rapid development of the Edwards Aquifer recharge zone and the development of lands near Camp Bullis. Following are details on the press conference.
